








RIAA Changes Litigation Strategy

- Background
 - Litigation goal: show P2P users they are not anonymous on the web
 - Litigation method
 - Bad PR
- New Strategy: ISP "cooperation"
 - No new litigation, but pursue ongoing cases
 - Agreements "in principle" for ISPs to forward warning letters to subscribers, slow connection, and perhaps terminate connection entirely

- YouTube Partnerships to Monetize User-Posted content
- Amended complaint
 - Deals to monetize content show:
 - Technical feasibility of filtering
 - **YouTube's willingness to profit from infringement**
